Note)

- *1) For freshman (exchange student), no program is available. However if an Iraqi university and a Japanese university agree on inter-university students exchange agreements, freshman can study abroad in a Japanese university as an exchange student.
- *2) Universities which have master courses will be held in English
- *3) Undergraduate means the student who has completed 12 years of regular school education or has graduated from a school equivalent to an upper secondary school
- *4) Freshman means the student who is still studying in a university.
- *5) Graduate means the student who has graduated from a university.

The student coming from Abroad is treated as the same as domestic (Japanese) Student. Accordingly, the language eligibility is necessary. To learn the subject, and to keep the communication in other students, or with Professors during the study, Japanese Language ability is one of the key factors to achieve the successful end of the Study for Bachelor Course and Master Scholarship Course. Only PhD course requires the enough ability for English, because of the methods in the Study. In PhD Course, the majority of the discussion and investigation would be operated by English.

Table 2 shows the requirements of language abilities for general admissions in the concerned universities.

1. Scholarships & Allowances

It is generally understood that Living in Japan is expensive. To support the student coming from Abroad, Japanese Government has arranged the following Scholarship.

- 1) Japanese Government Scholarship (MEXT)
This system is applied for undergraduate students can receive ¥117,000-¥120,000/Month for 5 years including Japanese-language training period. In case of the graduate students the monthly amount is ¥143,000-¥148,000 for 2 years including Japanese-language training period. The tuition will be waived and the travel allowance which is roundtrip fare (air ticket) will be provided.
- 2) YKK Leaders 21
This Scholarship is applied for the graduate students with monthly amount of ¥200,000 for 2 years (master course) or 3 years (PhD course). The tuition is not waived but ¥2,500,000 will be provided for school fee. (For listed universities except Waseda University, annual tuition is around ¥500,000. For Waseda University, annual tuition is around ¥1,000,000).

2. Scholarship Application

Both of the introduced Scholarships is required to be applied from Iraq before starting studying in Japan. The application methodologies on each Scholarship are shown below.

- 1) Japanese Government Scholarship
It is recommended to start the application of this Scholarship one (1) year before studying in Japan. The applicant is asked to undertake as below.
 - a. Declaration of Preferred Course to Japan Embassy in Iraq
Applicants will take primary selection of studying course. As per the preference declaration by Applicant, Japanese Embassy in Iraq will assess applicants—through their applications' documents, writing examinations, and interviews.
 - b. Qualification by Japanese Embassy
As per the course and decree, the qualification would be done for Bachelor Course and for Master Course independently. Standard Qualification for each course would be:
 - a) Bachelor Course
 - Mathematic
 - English and Japanese
 - Two from Physics, or Chemistry, or Biology
 - b) Master Course
 - English
 - Japanese, but not mandatory to be efficient
 - c. Contact with Preferable University
Upon qualified, the Applicant is asked contact directly the Japanese University on his/her choice in order to obtain the admission.
 - d. MEXT Qualification
The Applicant is asked to receive the qualification from MEXT through the above.

In the case of Iraqi students, Japanese embassy in the republic of Iraq makes announcement about MEXT scholarship., The application procedures are as follows.

- Application closes at the end of 2nd Quarter.
- Primary Qualification takes

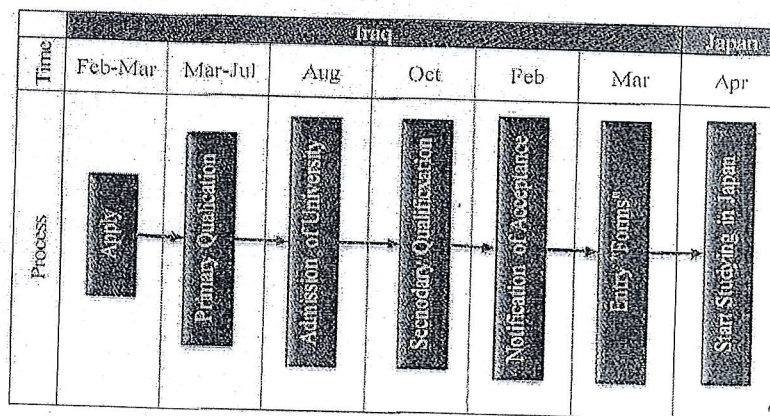


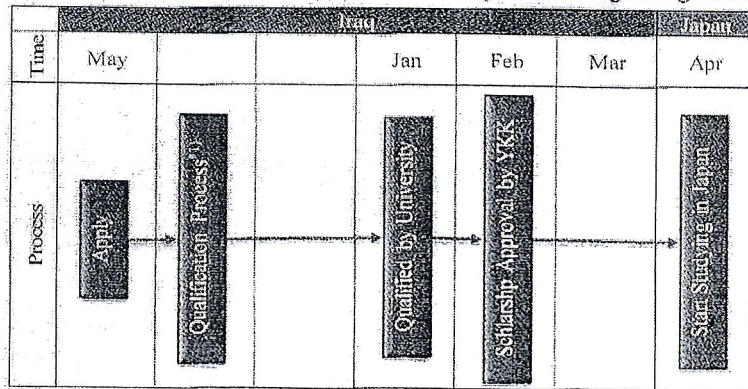
Fig-1 Application of Japanese Government Scholarship

place in the beginning of 3rd Quarter (Duration is expected to 2-3 weeks)

- Successful candidates are given a letter by the embassy to certify their passing the Primary Qualification.
- Qualified or not Qualified would be informed by MEXT between the end of year or the end of 1st Quarter
- During the period, the Applicant is asked to decide the study subject through the discussion with his/her professor in Iraq
- Upon the selection of Study Course, the Contact with Japanese University is asked to be started.
- They should also contact their universities' international student offices or equivalent regarding travel, accommodation, etc.
- Successful candidates can start the study in Japan from the freshman's season, or other defined month by the University

2) YKK Leaders 21

YKK Leaders 21 is a private scholarship governed by Yoshida Scholarship Foundation. It takes nearly one year for applicants to know the result. Selecting process depends on university.

3. Possible Scholarship

The available Scholarship for Foreign Student are as below. However, in order to apply the ones shown below requires some action as Iraq Government to be usable.

1) Asian Development Bank, Japan Scholarship

This program is applied for the Under Development Countries, participated to ADB. The purpose of this program is development of human reservoir for the national improvement. The person who would like to study in master course can apply to this scholarship. This scholarship covers tuition, living expense, medical insurance, and a round-trip fee. Iraq is currently not the member of ADB.

At the current situation, Iraq Student cannot apply this Scholarship, because of Iraq's Non-Participation to ADB. When Iraq joins to the member of ADB, the Iraq Student can apply this Scholarship.

2) Yokohama National University (YNU)*

Yokohama National University has been collaborating with the World Bank and provides English course with Full Scholarship. Approximately fifteen scholarships are allocated to the YNU program by the World Bank. Each scholarship provides a monthly allowance of ¥152,000 and a round-trip air ticket to Japan plus a travel allowance of USD500.

The scholarship also covers tuition fees, the entrance examination fee and the admission fee. Citizens of Bottom of Pyramid countries in the World Bank member countries are eligible for the scholarships. Applicants must be 35 years old or younger as of April 1, 2013. Applicants must have at least four years of practical experience involving responsibility for infrastructure development and must also intend to pursue a career in the field of development.

As per the guideline, Iraq is categorized into Middle Class. This application was submitted in 1980's. When Iraq Government would like to use this scholarship, the re-submission of the application is necessary. If the World Bank categorizes Iraq as re-submit the application to show the current status. Also, by submitting the application, World Bank would analyze Iraq categorized into this category, or not.

It is believed it hard for Iraq to categorized to Bottom of Pyramid Grade.

Note*: The Infrastructure Management Program at YNU is oriented to train only government officials in the field of engineering (non-governmental officials are not applicable).
